The changes to the Architecture Studies Minor are a result of the changes to the curriculum for the Bachelor of Architecture degree and the Bachelor of Science degree

emerge from the need to accommodate the new College of Arts and Architecture core curriculum for first-year students, comprising A&A 101(3), A&A 102S(3), A&A 103(3), and A&A 104(3) and an increase in the credits for ARCH 231(6) and ARCH 232(6).

Minor Curriculum structure

The overall credit hour requirements and the structure of the Architecture Studies Minor does not change.

Course Drops

Four courses will be dropped.

- Arch 110(3), ARCH 111(3), ARCH 131S(3), and ARCH 132(3) are being replaced by the four new courses in the College of Arts and Architecture core curriculum, A&A 101(3), A&A 103(3), A&A 102S(3), and A&A 104(3).

Course Changes

- Two course changes reflect an increase in course credits. This is to better reflect the amount of time spent by the students for this course work. ARCH 231(6) and ARCH 232(6) meet 12 hours per week, far exceeding the traditional contact hours.

These changes do not affect the instructional, educational, and course objectives as described for the minor. They do not entail any changes in the evaluation methods to be employed. The relationships/linkages of these courses to other courses remains intact. Each maintains its existing relationship to the major.

While consultation with other appropriate departments and academic support has taken place, these classes are not offered at any other colleges or at any other Penn State campuses; thus there is no duplication of instruction. Each continues to draw upon the same special facilities, the design studios, and their associated equipment, making no additional demands on university facilities. Similarly, there are no additional technology needs beyond those already in place. Frequency of offerings and enrollment remain as at present.

Impact on enrollment

There is no anticipated change in enrollment.

The Architecture Studies Minor revision was circulated to all faculty in the College of Arts and Architecture and all Associate Deans of colleges at University Park and the chief academic officers, or their representatives, at all other campuses.
